**Minutes:**

01/07/15 The minutes of the meeting held on 14 April 2014 were read & accepted as a true record.

**Matters Arising:**

02/07/15 The northbound slip road has been resurfaced

03/07/15 Slurry sealing has still not been carried out on Moor Row

04/07/15 Speed concerns have been address by NYCC & a survey which was carried out showed that there was not a large amount of speeding taking place on Moor Road.

05/07/15 Only two residents attended the litter pick

**Residents Questions:**

06/07/15 Residents voiced their concerns with regards to Northfields. They have undergone a variety of disruptions due to building works; a biomass boiler in an outside shed which probably contravenes the allowed building height was a cause for concern plus the boiler emits black smoke & smells which spoils the residents' enjoyment of their gardens. Originally the property was to be home to 6 people but now the owners wish to raise the number to 8. The Council will write to HDC Planning department with regard to the amount of traffic the property is generating & to Environmental Health with regard to the Biomass boiler.

07/07/15 The Moor Road continues to deteriorate. In some places the road has collapsed, residents are claiming for damages included broken springs on their vehicles; a cyclist was injured after hitting a pothole. The verges have disappeared; vehicles are grounding. Cllr G. Dadd stated that NYCC Highways were looking for a way to fund the repairs. He suggested that a meeting be arranged between NYCC Highways, residents, Parish Councillors & himself to discuss the situation.
